**Tour du Canada** — Vancouver to St. John's, June 20 - August 31 — a 10-week cross-country camping trip in the *coureur de bois* tradition that travels through all 10 provinces.

7,665 kilometres (4,730 miles), daily average 131 kilometres (81 miles), 59 ride days, 11 rest days, 62 nights camping, 10 indoors, all meals, 3 ferry crossings. **\$4,150.00**

**Tour TransCanada** — Vancouver to St. John's, June 13 - August 24 — a cross-country trip with a combination of indoor and camping. (Call for details on differences to Tour du Canada.)

7,440 kilometres (4,590 miles), daily average 126 kilometres (78 miles), 59 ride days, 11 rest days, 40 nights camping, 32 nights indoors, 51 breakfasts, 47 dinners, 3 ferry crossings. **\$7,975.00**

**Tour Arctic** — Vancouver to Inuvik, July 17 - August 10 — through Vancouver Island and by ferry to Skagway, then north to Whitehorse, Dawson and beyond the Arctic Circle.

1,945 kilometres (1,200 miles), daily average 101 km. (63 mi.), 19 ride days, 5 rest days, 18 nights camping, 7 nights indoor, 20 breakfasts, 20 dinners, 2 major ferry crossings. **\$3,995.00**

**Tour Atlantic** — Halifax to Baddeck, August 13 - August 27 — the Nova Scotia south shore to the Annapolis Valley to New Brunswick's Fundy region to P.E.I. and the Cabot Trail.

1,400 kilometres (865 miles), daily average 117 km. (72 mi.), 12 ride days, 2 rest days, 11 nights camping, 4 nights indoor, 12 breakfasts, 12 dinners, 2 ferry crossings. **\$1,450.00**

**Tour Pacific** — Vancouver to Calgary via the Icefields Parkway, June 26 - July 11 — from dense coastal forest to cattle country to high mountains and alpine meadows.

1,395 kilometres (860 miles), daily average 107 km (66 mi.), 13 ride days, 2 rest days, 13 nights camping, 3 nights indoor, 13 breakfasts, 14 dinners. **\$1,450.00**

**The BiQue Ride** — Toronto to Montreal, July 22 - July 28 — along Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence River through Empire Loyalist country and old canal routes in Quebec.

660 kilometres (410 miles), daily average 110 km. (68 mi.), 6 ride days, 1 rest day, 7 nights indoor, 7 breakfasts, 1 dinner. **\$875.00**

**The ByCycle Ride** — Toronto to Bytown (now called Ottawa), June 26 - July 1 — a trip to the National Capital that arrives on Canada Day.

515 kilometres (320 miles), daily average 102 km. (64 mi.), 5 ride days, 6 nights indoor, 5 breakfasts, 1 dinner. **\$875.00**

**Cabot Trail** — Charlottetown to Baddeck, August 22 - August 27 — the Birthplace of Confederation, hills and ocean views as far as the eye can see. A Down East Classic.

660 kilometres (405 miles), daily average 131 km. (81 mi.), 5 ride days, 2 nights indoor, 4 nights camping, 5 breakfasts, 5 dinners. **\$695.00**

**Icefields Parkway** — Jasper to Calgary, July 7 - July 11 — past glacial melt that flows to the Pacific and Arctic Oceans and then to Lake Louise and Banff.

440 kilometres (270 miles), daily average 109 km. (67 mi.), 4 ride days, 1 night indoors, 4 nights camping, 4 breakfasts, 4 dinners. **\$625.00**

**Niagara Vineyards** — Hamilton to Niagara Falls, August 19 - August 24 — through the wine region, along the Welland Canal between Lake Erie and Lake Ontario, and past The Falls.

300 kilometres (185 miles), daily average 60 km. (37 mi.), 5 ride days, 6 nights indoor, 5 breakfasts, 1 dinner. **\$975.00**

**Tour Vert** — Montreal to Quebec City, August 5 - August 10 — from Quebec's big city to its capital through the Townships that are popular summer vacation destinations.

485 kilometres (300 miles), daily average 97 km. (60 mi.), 5 ride days, 6 nights indoor, 5 breakfasts, 1 dinner. **\$875.00**

**Voyageur Route** — Ottawa to Quebec City, July 8 - July 13 — along the banks of the Ottawa, Richelieu and St. Lawrence Rivers, ancient canoe routes to the continental interior.

545 kilometres (335 miles), daily average 109 km. (67 mi.), 5 ride days, 6 nights indoors, 5 breakfasts, 1 dinner. **\$875.00**

**Southern Ontario Century Ride** — an early season warm-up weekend ride, May 26 -27, Toronto to Barrie and return. Choice of 100 kilometres or 100 miles out and back.

1 night indoor, single or a suite for couples, 1 dinner, 1 breakfast. \$115.00 before March 5; \$125 after March 5
